

The DPJL replaced the former 2005 Law on 25th May 2018. It mirrors many of the provisions of GDPR and its purpose is to protect natural persons in relation to the processing and free movement of their personal information. Fundamentally, the Law is about updating and extending the provisions that have been in place for many years to recognise technological advancements, and to provide individuals with greater control over what happens to their personal information. It includes additional rights for data subjects and greater accountability and transparency requirements for organisations.

RULES AND COURT ETIQUETTE

Fair Use of the Courts

- 1 Duration of Play:** Please stick to your booked time slot, and on the court number you booked.
- 2 Involve waiting players:** Players engaged in a singles game are encouraged to invite players waiting to form a four for doubles, if all courts are in use.
- 3 Club Matches, Events and Coaching:** Any club matches, events and planned coaching will whenever possible be booked out at least seven days before the date of play or otherwise as soon as possible. These activities will take priority over social matches. Court 2 is marked out for coaching and will take priority over social tennis on this court. Members and Guests using this court must quickly yield to coaches then complete their game on another court as soon as one is available.

Club Sessions

- 4 Club sessions:** Club balls will be available. Members are to pay £1 per club session.
 - a. All members are welcome to attend on Sunday mornings 10am – 12pm & Wednesday evenings from 6.30 until 8pm.
 - b. All junior members together who know the rules and can score, serve and rally with yellow ball, are welcome to attend these sessions.

Guests

- 5** There is a charge of £5 payable in respect of a non-member playing as a guest of a member. Please either leave the cash in the letterbox for this purpose at the courts or pay via BACS. An **adult** member may bring **up to 3 guests [Junior members 1 playing guest if supervised by an adult]** on any one day and each guest should not exceed **3** visits per year.

Dress

- 6** **IT IS COMPULSORY FOR NON-MARKING SHOES SUITABLE FOR TENNIS TO BE WORN** by everyone on court. "Astro trainers" damage the surface and are NOT permitted. Everybody within the boundary fence must wear their tops at all times.

Security

- 7** Members must not disclose the gate code combinations to anyone. Those who should know it will have been given the information in writing. Refer all enquiries to the Membership Secretary.
- 8** **IT IS VITAL TO ENSURE THAT THE COURTS AND CLUBHOUSE ARE LOCKED** when you have finished playing, if they are not in use by others. Those adult members requiring the access code must apply to the Membership Secretary in writing.

Care of the Courts and Clubhouse

- 9** Please pay due attention to the condition of the court surfaces, nets, and clubhouse. Should you find any instances of undue wear and tear or damage, please notify a Committee member.
- 10** Every effort should be made to keep the surface of the courts clean and unmarked.
- 11** In winter months and after wet weather, members are requested to change into their tennis shoes in the clubhouse's changing room to avoid bringing mud from outside into the courts.
- 12** Please keep the clubhouse and changing rooms clean and tidy at all times.
